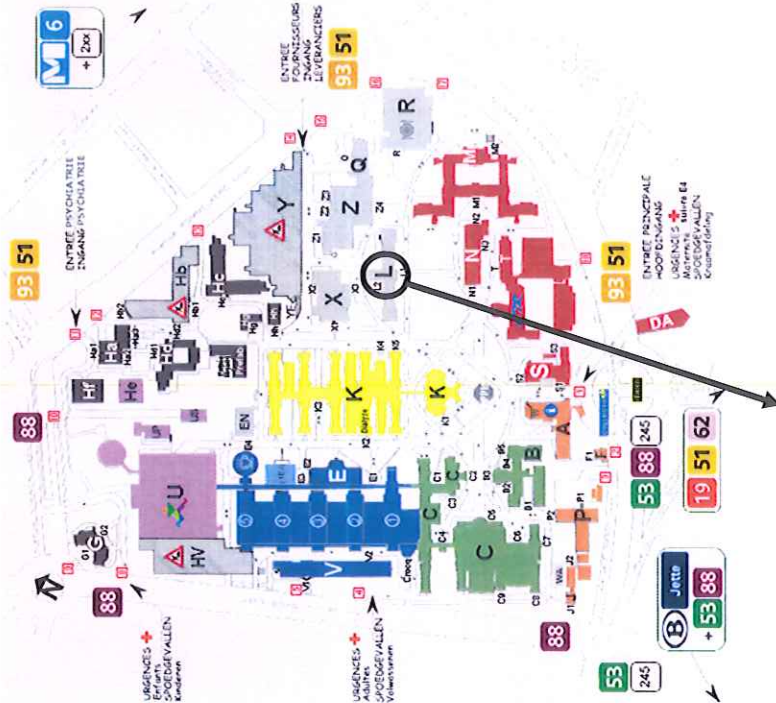

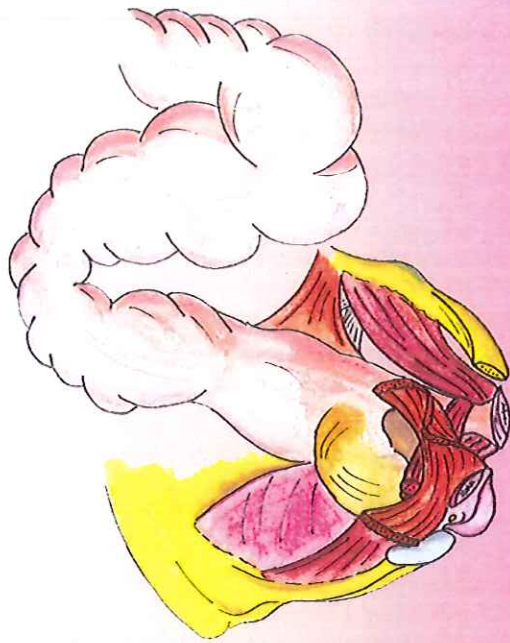
Parking—mobility
